- 1. The County reserves the right to move teams as necessary to attempt to balance the leagues. This includes regular season and playoffs.
- 2. **Roster:** Any additions must be postmarked one day prior to the game in which the new player participates. The deadline for adding new players to the roster is June 1. **Note:** A player may not participate on more than one team in the same league, or he will be declared ineligible to compete for the remainder of the season. Rosters are unlimited. Pick up players are illegal.
- 3. The Azalea B League is a <u>Recreational</u> League. This league is for the groups just getting together to play once a week or so. <u>No tournament players</u>* are allowed in this league. Any team or player violating this rule will be subject to removal from the league (No refunds). Players could be subject to removal from all teams in the County. * <u>Tournament players</u> are defined as players that play in 3 or more weekend tournaments per calendar year, excluding the Richmond Round Robin on Memorial Day.
- 4. The approved ball list and non-approved ASA ball list were distributed at the coaches meeting on 3/13. The approved and non-approved ball list can be found under the Umpires and Rules section of http://centralvirginiaasa.com/
- 5. **Schedule:** There will be a 28 game schedule. Playoffs will include all teams playing a double-elimination tournament.
- 6. **Tie Games:** A tie game during the regular season will be considered in the final standings as one-half win and one-half loss and will be figured this way in order to compute the team's won-lost percentage. Runs scored or allowed will not determine any ties in standings.
- 7. **Home Team:** Home team is responsible for a scorekeeper and an official scorebook.
- 8. **Playing Rules:** Playing rules are in complete compliance with the Amateur Softball Association's official 2012 Rules unless otherwise noted. No metal cleats are allowed.
- 9. **Game Times:** The following is a time schedule for each game, but teams must be at the location ready to play at the designated times on the schedule.

a. 1st game
b. 2nd game of 1st set
c. 3rd game
d. 4th game of 2nd set
6:30
7:00 forfeit
8:10
8:40 forfeit

- e. In the event of a tie and the time has expired, no inning will be allowed in an attempt to break the tie. If the preceding game runs over, your game will still be allotted 50 minutes. Make sure that the umpire and the opposing team manager all agree on the time that the game starts and the time the game is to conclude. 5 minute grace period for 1st game only. It does cut into game time.
- 10. Slaughter Rule-20 after 3, 15 after 4 and 10 after 5.
- 11. **Protests:** All protests, playing rules/eligibility must be filed, in writing, to Caitlin Wampler, Henrico County Recreation, P. O. Box 90775, Henrico, Virginia 23273-0775, within 48 after the conclusion of the game to be considered.

- 12. **Umpires:** In the event that no umpire shows up, each manager should designate a representative to umpire. If an umpire cannot be agreed upon, games will be scheduled at later date.
- 13. Make-up Games: Make-up games will be rescheduled by the County and must be played as scheduled. We will email out the schedule of make-up games, which will take place anywhere, any day of the week. www.co.henrico.va.us/rec Click on Sports Associations & Cancellations.
- 14. Alcoholic Beverages or Illegal Drugs: The consumption of alcoholic beverages or use of illegal drugs is not permitted on any County facility. Any player in violation of this will be suspended for 4 games and the games played on the night of the offense will be forfeited. This includes the parking lots and any County property.
- 15. **Game Scores**: It is the responsibility of **each team, win or lose,** to report the results of the game to the League President within 48 hours. If this is not done, both teams will receive losses for both games.
- 16. Manager Changes: In the event a team manager moves or a new team manager is appointed, please contact Caitlin Wampler at 501-5099 and Ann Taylor at 266-8317 immediately and give this information to them.
- 17. **Field Cancellations:** If the playability of fields is questionable due to inclement weather, contact the Henrico Sports Line, 501-5132, after 3:00 p.m. Otherwise, all decisions are left to the discretion of the field worker. Their word is final.
- 18. **Unsportsmanlike Conduct:** The unsportsmanlike conduct rule will be in effect for all games. If a player is ejected from the first game, he/she will not be allowed to play in the second game. If a player is ejected from the second game, he/she will not be allowed to play in the next two scheduled games. If deemed necessary, the County to reserves the right to increase or decrease the suspension of a player.
- 19. # of Batters: You may bat as many as you want, you have to bat at least the number of players you have in the game.
- 20. # of Players: You may start with 8 players and increase to 10 during the game. You will not be required to strike-outs outs for having less than ten players unless it is due to an ejection.
- 21. Stealing: Not allowed
- 22. **Courtesy Runners:** One courtesy runner allowed per inning. It does not necessarily have to be the last person up to bat.
- 23. Home Run: 3 and then 1 up then singles
- 24. 3 balls, 2 strikes with no courtesy
